Canal Fees

Lockage:

Parks Canada is proposing a per use fee structure that uses tickets that are redeemed for individual lockages.

The individual fee is dependent on the size of the boat and the location of the purchase:

For purchases made...	Pleasure Boaters Fee, per foot	Example, for a 25ft pleasure boat	Commercial Boaters Fee, per foot
At the canal	\$0.30	$\$0.30 \times 25 = \7.50 per ticket	\$0.60
On-line (-10% discount)	\$0.27	$\$0.27 \times 25 = \6.75 per ticket	\$0.54
On-line, bulk (- 25% discount)	\$0.23	$\$0.23 \times 25 = \5.75 per ticket	\$0.46

The number of tickets required to pass through a lock station will be based on the service provided at that lock station. There are three levels of service for lock stations:

Service	Description	# Tickets Required
Level I	Single lock chamber Low elevation Transit time of approximately 15 minutes	2 tickets
Level II	Single or multi-lock chamber Medium elevation Transit time of 15 to 30 minutes	3 tickets
Level III	Multi-lock chamber High elevation Transit time of 45 minutes or more	4 tickets
